

LEADERSHIP CHALLENGE - PLEASE GIVE GENEROUSLY

Tonight, our leadership challenge will focus on fundraising for the new Milan and Maureen Ilich Medical Imaging Centre in the new Yurkovich Family Pavilion.

With a lead donation of \$10 million from the Milan and Maureen Ilich family plus additional donations of \$4 million from donors, we are well on our way to achieving our \$20 million goal. By raising your hand and making a gift tonight, you too will ensure state-of-the-art equipment and technology can provide comprehensive diagnostic imaging for physicians and surgeons to diagnose illness and help monitor progression and treatments.

In 2021, the B.C. Provincial Government approved plans to build the Yurkovich Family Pavilion, a new full-service acute care tower at Richmond Hospital. The first phase is expected to open in 2027 with a new medical imaging centre, emergency department, and operating centre.



Chances are, every one of us has benefitted from an X-ray, ultrasound, CT or MRI scan. Throughout one's life, medical imaging plays a significant role in our health and lives. Physicians and surgeons rely on medical imaging technology to provide accurate and timely care, and this need is growing exponentially. Today, 115,000 patients in the community require medical imaging services each year and by 2035, the medical imaging department in Richmond Hospital is expected to serve over 200,000 patients each year.

This expansion will include a significant increase of equipment to enable timely and enhanced access for patients, purchase the latest technologies to provide improved image quality, reduce radiation exposure, and help avoid invasive medical procedures where possible. It will also include satellite imaging services in the future Emergency Department to help expedite diagnoses and care.
